## **Course Package Export and Import**

### Export course package:

A service available within the Blackboard system where exporting a course creates a package of course content that can later be imported into other sections of the course or into the same course in future semesters.

.To add Course content, log in to Blackboard at Al-Jouf University and navigate to your course Then follow these steps



 From the Course Menu go to *control panel*, choose *Packages and Utilities*, then choose Export/Archive Course.
