

Admission Requirements

The applicant must be Saudi or born to a Saudi mother.

01

The applicant must hold a high school certificate or its equivalent from inside or outside the Kingdom.

02

The applicant must have taken the National Center for Assessment tests (Qudrat + Tahsili for scientific, engineering, and health colleges).

03

The applicant must be medically fit according to each college's admission policies.

04

No more than two years should have passed since obtaining the high school certificate for applicants to health specialties.

05

The applicant must successfully pass any test or interview required by the University Council or College Council.

06

The applicant must fulfill any other conditions specified by the University Council.

07

If employed in a government or private sector, the applicant must obtain approval from their employer to study.

08

Students already enrolled in another university degree program, whether at the same university or another institution, may not be admitted.

09



Admission Regulations

01

Admission is conducted annually (at the beginning of each academic year), and the University Council may grant exceptions.

02

Admission is granted directly to colleges according to the admission requirements approved and announced by the University Council.

03

Some colleges may require additional criteria for continuing studies after completing at least one semester during the first year, subject to approval by relevant committees and councils.

04

Admission to all Applied College programs is through the common track of the Applied College.

05

Students are assigned to diploma programs after successfully completing the common track according to the following:

- Meeting the conditions approved by the Applied College Executive Council, provided the GPA is not less than 2 out of 5.
- Placement into programs after completing the common English language track based on:
 - 50% weighted admission score
 - 50% GPA achieved after completing the common language track.

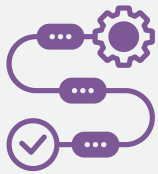

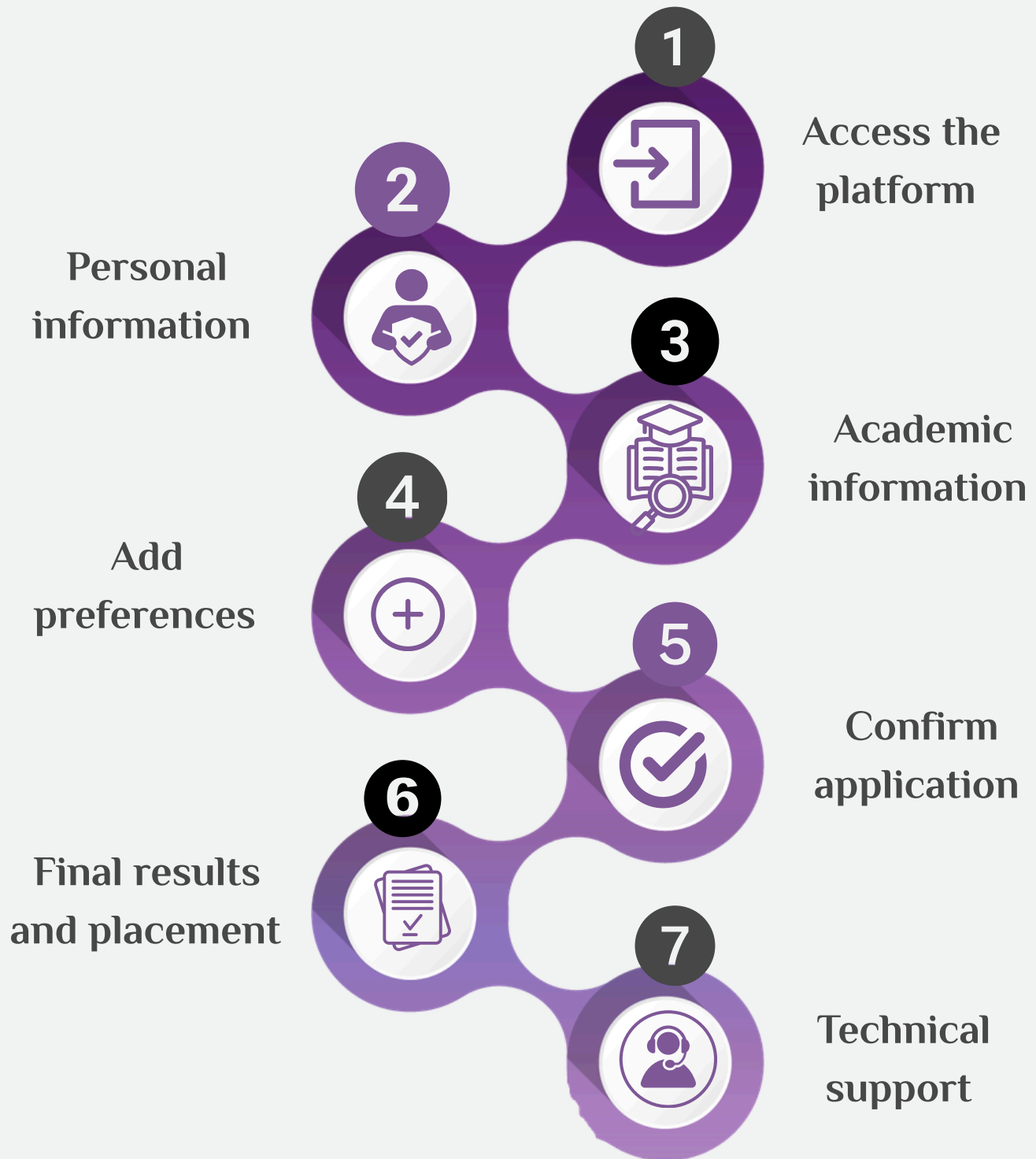

Frequently Asked Questions

01

Is there admission priority based on application date?

No. There is no priority based on the application submission date, as long as the application is submitted within the specified period.

02

Is there admission during the second semester?

If admission becomes available, it will be announced during the relevant period.

03

Do recent high school graduates receive priority?

No. Admission priority is based on achieving the highest scores according to the announced admission criteria and approved college policies.

04

Is choosing the same major at more than one university considered one preference?

No. Students may choose the same major at multiple universities.

05

Are students with high school certificates from outside the Kingdom required to take Qiyas tests?

Yes. All applicants with high school certificates from outside the Kingdom must take the National Center for Assessment tests.



Frequently Asked Questions

06

Is the application paper-based or electronic?

The application is fully electronic. No documents are required unless in special cases, such as:

- Non-Saudi students born to Saudi mothers
- Students with certificates from outside the Kingdom and equivalency certificates.

07

Can non-Saudi residents apply for admission?

Distinguished resident students may be admitted according to the regulations governing Saudi universities during the internal scholarship admission period.

08

Can preferences be reordered after saving?

Yes, through an admission modification request.

09

How do students log in to the platform for the first time?

Students log in through the Unified National Access Portal.

10

What does “annual admission” mean?

It means admission applications are accepted only once at the beginning of the academic year, with no admission period in the second semester.



Frequently Asked Questions

11

Can students choose the admission semester?

Yes. The semester is specified in the specialization details when adding it to the preference list.

12

Can the specialization be changed after final admission?

No. Changing specialization after final admission is not allowed.

13

Are admission criteria fixed and unified for all specializations?

No. Each specialization has different admission criteria, which can be viewed on the specialization information page.

14

Can all preferences be selected within one university only?

Yes, provided that the total number of preferences is not less than 25 specializations and includes at least one preference in the Technical and Vocational Training Corporation.
